Pupil A	£1300	A live musician delivered themed sessions with a range of instruments including sensory props to support communication & cognition.	<p>Pupil A progress: Communication has increased by 9% Cognition increased by 7%.</p> <p>Pupil A is more aware of what is happening around them. They are now able to recognise certain activities and will anticipate and vocalise more. They can also recognise a range of instruments.</p>
Pupil B	£935	Additional support given to raise confidence in mobility. RNIB to teach cane training.	<p>Pupil B has increased his physical progress by 15% Pupil B continues to lift their head when walking in school corridors. Pupil B now uses their hands to trail and understands significant words to understand and use in their environment. Pupil B now uses a cane to explore their outdoor environment.</p>
Pupil C	£935	Additional staffing to support hydrotherapy sessions for well-being.	<p>Pupil C - a wheel chair user, very much looked forward to the hydrotherapy sessions and shower every week. They enjoyed the interaction with the staff and a complete sense of well-being following the session.</p>
Pupil D	£1300	Additional staffing to support sensory integration	<p>Pupil D progress: English writing up by 95% PSHE up by 95%</p> <p>Sensory integration enabled pupil D to remain calm at lunchtime and helped to develop eating skills.
